Settlement Services For Newcomers

The overall goal for CDSS is the successful integration of newcomers into the community so that they understand life in Canada including laws, rights, responsibilities, how to access community resources, setting them on a path to integration & full citizenship.

To provide newcomers with timely, accurate and relevant information on a broad spectrum of settlement and integration issues they need about Canada and the community in which they intend to settle.

To reach out newcomers in the community through promotion and marketing materials such as flyers, brochures and posters and disseminate our services in the community.

To organize group orientation sessions on a broad range of topics such as housing, health, education, employment, credential assessment to expedite the settlement of the newcomers in a planned manner.

Through one-on-one counselling & workshops topics such as workforce integration, Citizenship, school system, etc. information will be provided so that newcomers can make appropriate informed decisions. Through a needs assessment process newcomers short- & long-term goals will be identified along with steps needed to achieve these goals.

Community Development Through Arts

We are open to all ages and offer variety of programs that enables anyone to expand their views and become connected and engaged.
